ATTICUS ADMINISTRATION, LLC has been retained as the third-party Settlement Administrator in the above-referenced putative class action lawsuit (the “*Goldstein Action*”) pending in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York (the “Court”).

This notice is being provided to you in accordance with the Class Action Fairness Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1715, to inform you of a proposed class action settlement for the *Goldstein Action* in which Plaintiffs alleged that Defendants Mutual of America Life Insurance Company and the Mutual of America Investment Manager Committee breached their fiduciary duties under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (“ERISA”), 29 U.S.C. § 1001, et seq., in connection to the management of the Mutual of America Life Insurance Company Savings Plan.

The terms of the proposed class-action settlement are stated in the Settlement Agreement and the Proposed Order of Preliminary Approval. There are no contemporaneous settlements or other agreements between the Class Counsel and counsel for Defendants.

Plaintiffs filed a motion on April 14, 2023, requesting preliminary approval of the proposed settlement. The Court has not yet granted preliminary approval of the proposed settlement, nor has it scheduled a Fairness Hearing. The Court has scheduled a preliminary approval hearing on June 6, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 20D, 500 Pearl Street, New York, NY 10007. A final judgment has not been entered in this action, and no notice of dismissal has been filed at this time.

At this time, no written judicial opinions have been issued in this action relating to the materials described in 28 U.S.C. § 1715(b)(3)-(6) regarding any proposed or final notification to the class members, any proposed or final class action settlement, any settlement or other contemporaneous agreement, or final judgment or notice of dismissal.
